How to get in - Admission Criteria for BSN

RAK College of Nursing offers the Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree in two streams (Stream A BSN & stream RN-BSN Program) Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) degree, Specialty - Adult Health Nursing, Psychiatric - Mental Health Nursing, Pediatric Nursing & Community Health Nursing and Master of Science in Midwifery. This is based on the priority needs of the country as presented by (UAE Nursing & Midwifery Council). All Nursing programs are accredited by the Commission for Academic Accreditation (CAA), Ministry of Education, (UAE). Program Duration: Bachelor of Science in Nursing Stream A (BSN): is a four-year, eight semester program. Stream B RN-BSN Bridge program: is a two-year, four-semester program.

12th Grade Minimum Requirements**UAE GSEC**

An aggregate of 70% in the grade 12 science stream/ Advanced stream of UAE GSEC of Ministry of Education. Preference in admission will be given to those with high scores in Biology and Chemistry/Physics or EMSAT score whichever is higher. Abu Dhabi Education Council stream students should similarly have 70% aggregate. Preference in admission will be given to those with high scores in Advanced Biology(level 3) and Advanced Chemistry(level 3) or EMSAT score whichever is higher.

Pakistan Boards/Certificate:

Higher Secondary School Certificate with aggregate of 55% can apply. Preference in admission will be given to those with high scores in Biology and Chemistry/Physics (Part 1 and Part 2 total).

Indian Curriculum:

All India Senior School Certificate XII std CBSE/ISCE exams with 55% aggregate can apply. However, preference in admission will be given to those with high scores in Biology and Chemistry/Physics courses.

Indian State board: 60% aggregate can apply. However, preference in admission will be given to those with high scores in

Applicants from any other foreign educational curriculum not listed above must have secured a minimum aggregate equivalent to UAE curriculum 70% as per International Conversion Table of World Education Standards.

Registered nurses who have completed Associate Degree / Diploma in Nursing from an accredited school of nursing with 70% aggregate with 2 years of clinical working experience (OR with 65%-69% in Associate Degree in Nursing /Diploma in Nursing

English language requirements for BSN & RN-BSN Programs:

Proficiency in English equivalent to a TOEFL score of 500 in paper-based test OR 61 in internet based test OR Academic IELTS score of 5 OR EmSAT Achieve- English score of minimum 1100.

- Copy of IELTS/TOEFL/EMSAT- English score.
- Copy of 12th grade mark sheet.
- Copy of RN license / MOH license.
- Copy of Certificate of showing proof of work experience of 2 years or more
- Copy of Equivalency certificate (for students who studied Diploma in Nursing outside UAE).
- One copy of passport along with residence visa (as applicable)
- One copy of Emirates ID card (as applicable).
- Attach one JPEG photo in online application form & submit 5 hard copy photos (passport-size) during admission.

Refund of Transport Fee:

Students who decide not to avail the bus facility within two weeks from the date of commencement of classes will be refunded 50% of the transport fee. Beyond 2 weeks, the total fee paid is non-refundable.

The refund policy applies to all semesters.

In the case of BSN/RNBSN and Master Programs, the University has already given a maximum discount against the declared fee in the Admission Brochure, therefore no other discounts including merit scholarships will be given to any student.

NOTE:

Fees are for the academic year 2022-2023 payable at the beginning of each semester. There are 2 semesters in an academic year, from September to January & February to June.

Fresh batch students will be allowed to pay the fee in two installments. In order to complete the registration process, a post-dated cheque for the second installment has to be mandatorily submitted along with the first installment.

Health Insurance card is mandatory for all students. RN-BSN Students should have a valid health insurance card from the Government or should be adequately covered under a health insurance by the current employer.

Students will be required to buy on their own the instruments, personal protective gear including uniforms, masks, gloves, books etc. as per each program requirement.
