### NOTE:

Fees are for the academic year 2022-2023 payable at the beginning of each semester. There are 2 semesters in an academic year, from September to January & February to June.

Fresh batch students will be allowed to pay the fee in two installments. In order to complete the registration process, a post-dated cheque for the second installment has to be mandatorily submitted along with the first installment.

Health Insurance card is mandatory for all students.

Students will be required to buy on their own the instruments, personal protective gear including uniforms, masks, gloves, books etc. as per each program requirement.

### Refund of Transport Fee:

Students who decide not to avail the bus facility within two weeks from the date of commencement of classes will be refunded 50% of the transport fee. Beyond 2 weeks, the total fee paid is non-refundable.

The refund policy applies to all semesters.

### Merit Scholarship / Fee Concession

20% concession in the tuition fee is provided for all students securing above 95% in overall aggregate in 12th grade/UAE GSCE /equivalent. This concession is limited to the first year only.

Subsequently, a student who secures annual Grade Point Average of 3.8 or above on a 4.0 scale in the year end exams, will be entitled for a 15% concession in the tuition fee for the following year.

Merit scholarship does not apply for transfer students who enrolled for few courses.

### Student Residence Facility:

State of the art Student Residence Facility is provided separately for Male and Female students by the Government of RAK located at close proximity of approx 1.5 km from the university.

Program Duration: The MD program is of six years duration. After graduation, one year intern-ship is required as per the guidelines of the Ministry of Health & Prevention (MOHAP) to practice medicine in the UAE

## Highlights

The MD curriculum fosters critical thinking and active learning. This is delivered through a preclinical curriculum that has been designed to integrate the different basic science courses to help students develop their clinical decision making abilities through active learning sessions like Team Based Learning, Case Based Learning and Self Directed Learning.

This is followed by clinical clerkship training in teaching hospitals, where different types of teaching methods are used to achieve the learning outcome.

Students come from diverse backgrounds and challenges- yet when they graduate they will be equipped with several skills in critical thinking, problem solving and in excellent communication.

## How to Get In - Admission Criteria

Apply online and attach the following documents

- Copy of marks card of GSCE 12th grade or equivalent.
- Copy of TOEFL / IELTS / EMSAT - English score.
- One copy of passport along with residence visa (as applicable).
- One copy of Emirates ID card (as applicable).
- Conduct or character certificate / reference letter from the school / college on letter head.
- Copy of Equivalency Certificate (for students who studied foreign curriculum in UAE).
- Attach one JPEG photo in online application form & submit 5 hard copy photos (passport-size) during admission.

Eligible applicants will be called for an interview and personality test at RAKMHSU campus based on the merit/marks secured in grade 12 examinations. Admission of international students will also depend on UAE immigration regulations regarding student visa

## 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Minimum Requirements

### 1. Admissions General Requirements

1. An EmSAT score of 800 for Arabic Language. Alternatively, the international students can register for a non-credited Basic Arabic Language course at the institution.
2. An EmSAT score of 900 in Mathematics or equivalent, plus scores of 900 in two of the three science subjects (Chemistry, Biology or Physics). In the case that EmSAT scores in Mathematics and two science subjects are not available, a candidate shall sit an equivalent Admission/Entrance Exam designed by the College which includes Chemistry, Biology, Physics and Mathematics.
3. Passing a personal interview set by the College in addition to other conditions of admission set by the university.

### 1.2 English language requirements for MD program:

An Emirates Standardized Test (EmSAT) score of 1100 for English Language or an equivalent English Proficiency Test approved by the CAA. (TOEFL score of 500 in paper-based test OR 61 in internet based test OR Academic IELTS score of 5)

### 2. Country Wise Curriculum Requirements:

#### 2.1 UAE Curriculum:

A minimum High School Average of 90% for Advanced Track or 85% for Elite Track or equivalent in Standardized International Systems is required with no admission of General Track applicants.

#### 2.2 American Curriculum:

An aggregate score of 90% is required. Preference in admission will be given to those with high scores in Biology and Chemistry/Physics. If Biology is not taken in 12th Grade, a SAT II score of 550 in Biology is required. SAT in Math and English required to be completed in school for obtaining Equivalency Certificate.

#### 2.3 International Baccalaureate:

Must have completed any six courses including Biology and Chemistry/Physics at the higher level and obtain IB score of at least 26.

#### 2.4 Pakistan Boards/Certificate:

For MD: Higher Secondary School Certificate with aggregate of 75% can apply. Preference in admission will be given to those with high scores in Biology and Chemistry/Physics (Part 1 and Part 2 total).

#### 2.5 Indian Curriculum:

All India Senior School Certificate XII std CBSE/ISCE exams with 75% aggregate can apply. However, preference in admission will be given to those with high scores in Biology and Chemistry/Physics courses.

**Indian State Board:** 80% aggregate can apply. Preference in admission will be given to those with high scores in Biology and Chemistry/Physics courses.

#### 2.6 British Curriculum:

- a. Students applying for the Doctor Of Medicine (MD) programs must have completed at least two Advanced Supplementary of AS level OR one A level in Biology with at least 'B and above' grade after having completed 5 IGCSE/GCSE or O levels with minimum grade of 'B and above' in O level courses (the aggregate is equal to 90%) equivalent to UAE curriculum.
- b. Only courses classified as academic will be considered for admission. Courses must include Physics, Chemistry and Biology with at least two of them including Biology at the AS level/A level.

#### 2.7 African Curriculum (WAEC/WASSCE etc.)

A & B combination of grades in 12th grades in Biology and Chemistry can be considered. Preference in admission will be given to those with high scores in Biology and Chemistry/Physics.

#### 2.8 Canadian Curriculum (Ontario/Alberta etc.)

An aggregate score of 90% is required. Preference in admission will be given to those with high scores in Biology and Chemistry/Physics.

Applicants from any other foreign educational curriculum not listed above must have secured a minimum aggregate equivalent to UAE curriculum 90% as per International Conversion Table of World Education Standards.
