- Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree with minimum CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent.
- Proficiency in English equivalent to a TOEFL score of 550 in paper-based test, 79 in internet based test. OR Academic IELTS score of 6 OR EmSAT Achieve- English score of 1400 OR equivalent tests prescribed by Ministry is required.
- One year of clinical experience in the area of Specialty for BSN applicants. They are as follows:
- (i) Either adult or community experience is necessary for the adult specialization.
- (ii) Either adult or community experience is necessary for the community specialization.
- (iii) Either paediatric or community experience with evidence that this has included paediatrics is necessary for the paediatric specialization.
- (iv) Psychiatric Mental Health experiences is necessary for the Psychiatric Mental Health specialization.
- (v) Midwifery experience is necessary for the Master of Science in Midwifery
 - Or 2-years post-diploma for the RN-BSN-qualified applicants
